Identify the Impacts of Climate Change on the transportation system in the OCPC region and assess the vulnerability of the system and develop adaptation strategies for management and mitigation while coordinating with federal and state directives and initiatives.

What is Climate Change?

Climate Change is an increase in global temperatures and extreme weather events as a result of increased levels of greenhouse gases and atmospheric pollution (in particular, carbon pollution).
